The 2021 edition of the popular **WPS K9 Unit Calendar** is now available for sale at both WPCU branches.

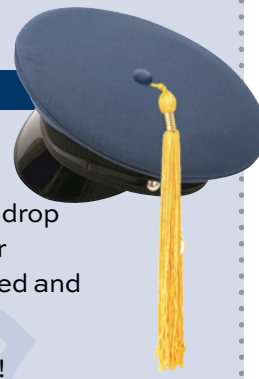
