The numbers are in from WPCU's latest member satisfaction survey, and the results, we're happy to report, are very positive. The survey consisted of eight questions related to WPCU's service, rates and fees — with a substantial majority of members either agreeing or strongly agreeing that **WPCU staff are friendly and professional; our staff are knowledgeable; accounts are handled accurately; investment and lending rates compare favourably to competitors; service charges are competitive; service and advice is in the member's best interest; and members are happy with WPCU's existing technology** (such as Internet banking and *Interac*® e-Transfer).

Members were also asked how likely they'd be to recommend WPCU to others, and those results are particularly strong (see chart).

Some of the most valuable information, though, came in the form of comments. Members' feedback provides us with insights into how we can grow our membership and the services and products members want to see WPCU offer in the future. We always take your feedback to heart and are actively and continuously looking for new ways to serve you even better.
